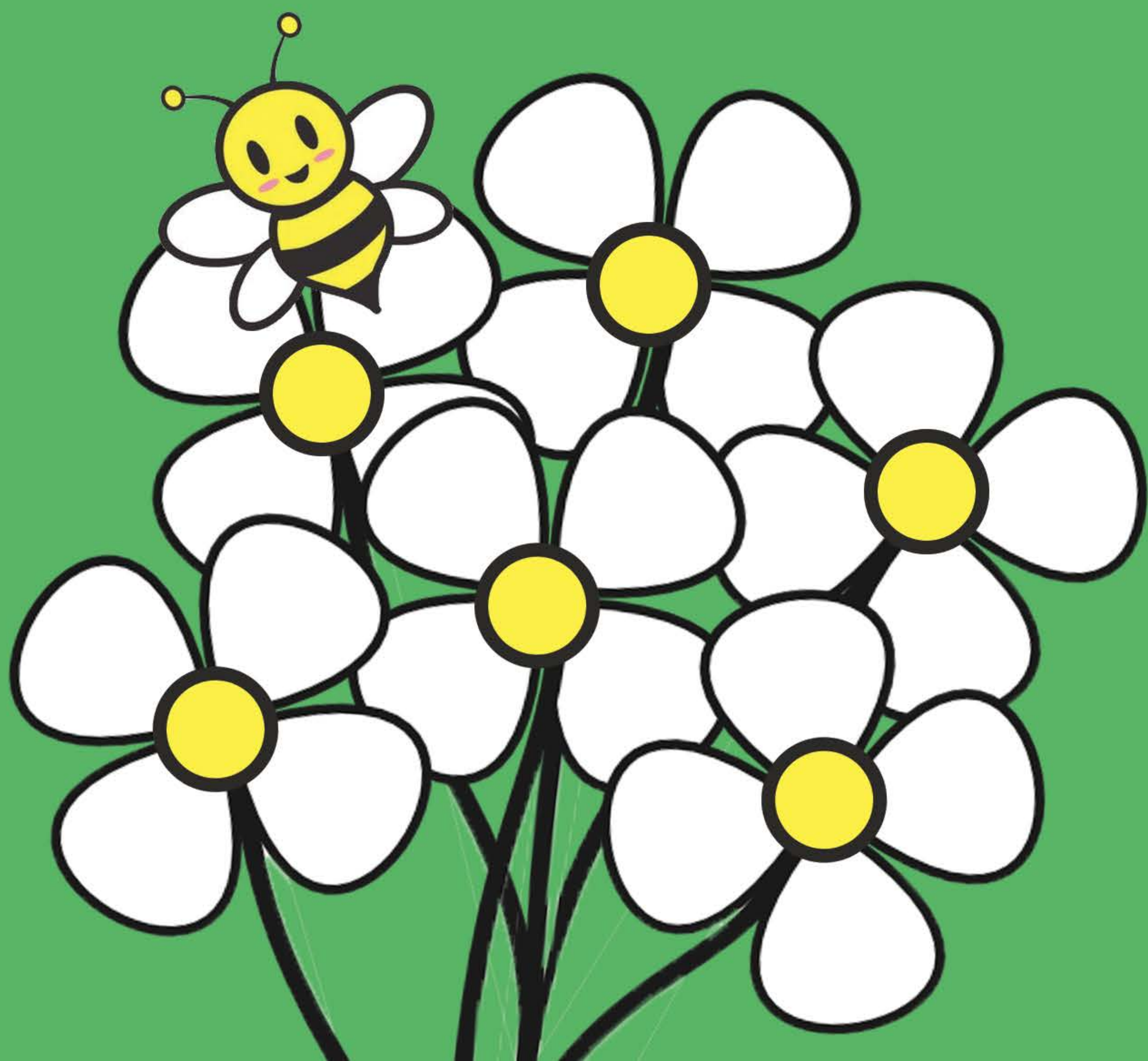

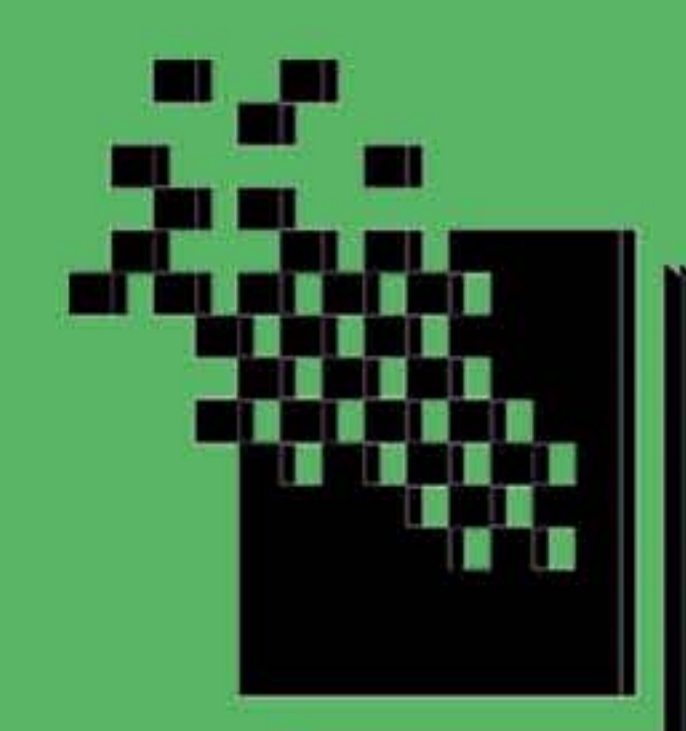


## An Author Event with Simon Choa-Johnston
