

Richmond Public Library's DEAR LIFE Book Bingo Contest

Play Richmond Public Library's *DEAR LIFE* Book Bingo to win a bag full of great fiction and nonfiction books to keep. This contest is open to adults and teens.

Contest Duration: July 8—August 22, 2020

How to Play:

- 1. Read or listen to books (or articles) according to the categories on the Bingo card and record the titles in the appropriate squares. Titles may be used only once per card.
- 2. Complete one row in any direction or four corners to get **one (1)** entry for the prize draw; or complete the whole card to get **ten (10)** entries.
- 3. Limit of one whole card entry or four different row entries per person.
- 4. Email the Bingo card with the entry form to: <u>contest@yourlibrary.ca</u>. This can be done by:
 - Emailing the fillable .pdf bingo card as an attachment;
 - Emailing a screenshot of the bingo card;
 - Emailing a photo of the bingo card; or
 - Email a list of titles you've read along with the corresponding row IDs or the corners.
- 5. The winners will be announced on August 23. The decisions of the judges are final.
- 6. One prize per person, four winners will be chosen at random.
